Alligators and crocodiles are similar in physical size, while caimans are about 40% smaller Male alligators can grow to more than 14 feet long and 1,000 pounds Females can exceed 10 feet and 250 pounds The growth rate of an alligator depends on diet, temperature, and sex To reach 6 feet in length, alligators take up to 10

Most crocodiles are more aggressive than the related alligators The two forms are distinguished by the long lower fourth tooth: in crocodiles, but not in alligators, this tooth protrudes on the side of the head when the mouth is closed Also, the snouts of most crocodiles are narrower than those of alligators
