4 The Civil War would see loss of human life at a rate previously unheard of in American combat Through 4 years of fighting, roughly 620,000 Americans (Union & Confederate) would die as a result of the Civil War More men died at the Battle of Gettysburg (51,112) than had perished in the Revolutionary War, the War of 1812, and the Mexican War
