Oxygen Desaturation (SpO2) - A drop in the level of oxygen present in the blood over a few seconds of time as a result of an apnea event or hypopnea event People who do not have sleep apnea or any other breathing problems usually have oxygen levels that stay between 93-98% in their blood Oxygen levels are considered abnormal when they fall
