Woods on a Snowy Evening" by Robert Frost Notice that the accented words (underlined) give the line a distinctive beat 2- Meter - a pattern of stressed and unstressed (accented and unaccented) syllables (known as a foot) in a line of poetry Example: In an iambic pentameter, the pattern is five iambic (unaccented + accented)
