### **Trigger Point Treatment: Ice and Stretch**

Rational for Icing When properly applied, icing causes a sudden drop in skin temperature that creates a continuous alarm signal to the spinal cord, which has an inhibitory effect on local pain signals, preventing them from reaching the brain This inhibits the protective spasming of the muscle, allowing the trigger points to be stretched<sup>1</sup>
