Olaudah Equiano (1745—1797) was eleven years old when he and his sister were kidnapped from their home in West Africa and sold to British slave traders Separated from his sister, Equiano was taken first to the West Indies, then to Virginia, where he was purchased by a British captain and employed at sea Renamed Gustavus Vassa, Equiano was enslaved for nearly ten
